[Gowda](#) announced a huge Rs 54,000 crore [package](#) to uplift the region's railway connectivity. Addressing a press conference in Guwahati, [Gowda](#) said that Assam alone would get Rs 5,400 crore to improve and expand railway network.

After reviewing the railway projects, he said that Assam will get seven new trains very soon.

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
