The Assam State Transport Corporation (ASTC), Bokakhat, earned Rs 30,03,155 in the year 2007, an increase of Rs 4,93,849 than the previous year. In the year 2006, the station got the third best station award of Asom. The station now earns almost an amount of Rs 11,000 per month from the commercial establishments including the canteen of the campus.
