

Bomb explosions in Tinsukia



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TINSUKIA: Despite tight security and round-the-clock vigil, [ULFA](#)(I) rebels exploded two powerful bombs in [Tinsukia](#) district amid the Republic Day celebrations on Friday.

The first explosion took place at 6 in the morning just a stone's throw away from the Jagun Police station where there is no report of any casualty.

The rebels exploded the second bomb in [Ledo](#) at around 7 in the morning. There is, however, no report of any casualty in the incident.

Security and civil top guns reached thr spots and intensified the counter insurgency operation two days after the rebels ambushed an army [vehicle](#) along the Assam-[Arunachal Pradesh](#) border where a jawan was killed.

The authority stepped up security to ensure peaceful Republic Day celebrations on Friday.

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
