

BPF backs NDA in Citizenship Bill

NDA has received a marginal shot on its arm in the move to amend The Citizenship Amendment Bill, [2016](#) when the Bodo Peoples' Front has come in full support of the Bill that triggers statewide protest.

Addressing a press conference in [New Delhi](#) on Tuesday the coalition partner president [Hagrama Mohilary](#) said that they have reasons to support the move.

"We support the move to amend the Bill to accept the Hindu migrants. It would have no adverse impact on Assam," said Hagrama.

But we [don't](#) endorse the idea of accepting the [Muslim](#) migrants," said the BTAD [chief](#) who arrived in the capital on Monday to formally give his party's stand on the crucial issue. BPF's position assumes importance at a time when its counterpart AGP has decided to oppose the move.
