

BPF winning 13 seats: Hagrama



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‘BPF party is winning all 13 contesting seats in the BTAD region, besides BJP led alliance party is forming government at Dispur’, said BPF president [Hagrama Mohilary](#).

Mohilary, who is also BTC [chief](#) said today on the concluding day of the party’s 3rd triennial convention held at Bodofa cultural complex that his making all laugh in all contesting seats in the region and government would be formed by BJP-BPF-AGP alliance parties. He said there is no influence of [Congress](#) and other parties while forming new government in the [state](#).
