The AASU leaders immediately brought the matter to the notice of the centre incharge at 10 am.

The OC Kalaigaon police station arrested Bhupen Barman alias Nalini Barman, who latter confessed that he had done the misadventure for Rs.20000. only. Mean while, real candidate Gopal Modak, son of a rich businessman Pradip Modak has been missing (?) till now raising question of a possible deal with investigating police.
