

Busy schedule in Majuli



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Political heavyweights have a hectic schedule in Majuli on Wednesday hardly a week before the Lok Sabha polls.

Chief minister Tarun Gogoi is visiting the river island on Wednesday to woo its voters.

During his day long trip, the chief minister is holding at least three poll rallies to campaign for Lakhimpur candidate Rane Narah. This is apart from his visit to the Vaishnavite monasteries.

BJP president Sarbananda Sonowal is also visiting Majuli on Wednesday to woo the voters. This river island falls in Lakhimpur Lok Sabha constituency where he is contesting in the first phase of polls slated for April 7.
