

Bwiswmuthiary released manifesto

Four times sitting MP and Independent candidate from No. 5 Kokrajhar Lok Sabha constituency Sansuma Khunggur Bwiswmuthiary released his election manifesto at Kokrajhar Press Club in Kokrajhar on Monday.
