A total of eight students among many participants from six blocks of [Aryabhata](#) Science centre of [Udalguri](#) district have been selected today for the [state level](#) science based competitions to be held at the Regional Science Centre, [Khanapara](#) to be organised by ASTEC (Assam Science [Technology](#) & [Environment](#) Council,Guwahati) In a district [level](#) science based competitions organized by the [Udalguri Aryabhata](#) Science Centre under the Assam Science and [Technology](#) and [Environment](#) Council (ASTEC) held at [Udalguri](#) Girls' HS school on October 25 which was organized by the [Udalguri](#) district administration.
