

Choppers back in Arunachal Pradesh



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Choppers are back to the sky of [Arunachal](#) Pradesh three months after a Pawan Hans chopper carrying [Tirap](#) Deputy Commissioner Kamalesh [Joshi](#) crash landed at Khunsa.

This time [Sky One](#) Airways Pvt Ltd starts operating the chopper service in from Naharlagun to Tawang via Guwahati. The service will operate on every Thursday & Friday from Naharlagun to Tawang. The present arrangement is purely temporary till resumption of service of 2nd MI-172 helicopter.

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
