

City bus service at night



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In a move that would encourage the late night commuters in Guwahati, the Assam State Transport Corporation is introducing night services across the [city](#) from Thursday. ASTC officials told Assam Times that the corporation initially is running 20 on three arterial routes from [8](#) at night.

“Our buses will ply on the [Khanapara](#) round trip covering Panbazar, Adabari, Basistha Chariali while another route will cover from Jalukbari to [Khanapara](#) via Adabari-Uzanbazar-Ganeshguri. The third route will cover from the Forest Gate to ISBT via Noonmati, Uzanbazar, Jalukbari,” said an ASTC official. The fares [against](#) the night bus service would be 50 per cent more than the existing fare of [city](#) buses.

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
