

Clear rivers & drains



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Stunned by widespread criticism in the time of [flood](#) and [landslide](#) in [Guwahati](#), chief minister has cleared a slew of measures to deal with the issue firmly.

After holding a crucial [meeting](#) with the Kamrup (metro) district administration on [Sunday](#) evening, [Gogoi](#) has asked the authorities to clear the rivers Bharalu, Bahini, Sorousola, Borsola, Silasaku immediately.

He further asked the [Guwahati](#) Municipal Corporation to clear the roads and [drains](#) in the city within the next 24 hours.

[Gogoi](#) started dealing with these firmly after rainwaters wreaked havoc in many parts of the city.

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
