

CM announces 13 parliamentary Secys



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In a bid to reward the MLAs who left dissidents, [chief](#) minister [Tarun Gogoi](#) has announced 13 parliamentary secretaries who would take oath on September 16. Gogoi on Monday announced Habul Chakravorty, Rupjyoti Kurmi, Ghanashyam Kalita, Hemanta Talukdar, Kamalakhya Purkayastha, Sushanta [Borgohain](#), Arun Phukan, Arati Kakati, Rumi Nath, SR Subba, Shivcharan Basumatary, Monica [Bora](#) and Jamaluddin Ahmed [as](#) new parliamentary secretaries.

Sources in the [chief](#) minister's office said Gogoi is gearing up for a minor expansion of his council of ministers where two of his colleagues would be dropped and three would be inducted. Assam Times [Political](#) Research Bureau broke the story last week how Gogoi was preparing to quell the dissidence and to reward a section of dissident MLAs who decided to remain with the [Congress](#).

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
