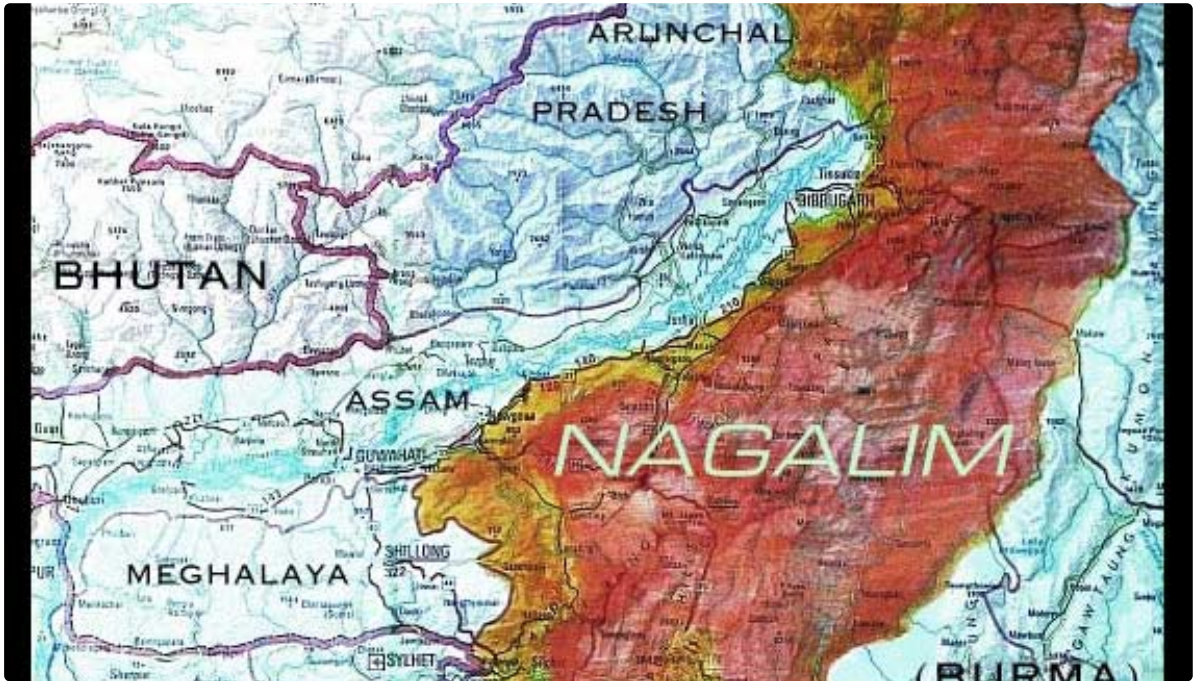


## Concern over truce violation
