

## Confident Gogoi casts vote in Jorhat

Assam Chief Minister Tarun Gogoi is confident that Congress would be able to retain power this time also. Talking to newsmen waiting at the polling booth in Jorhat, he said Congress will get absolute majority and would be able to form the next government.
