

Conrad to take oath as M'laya CM

SHILLONG: A non [Congress](#) coalition government is set to be installed in [Meghalaya](#). UDP legislative meeting which took place on Sunday morning at Donkuper [Roy](#)'s residents in Shillong announced support to NPP to form the government.

NPP chief Conrad Sangma accompanied by his legislators and their UDP and BJP counterparts are meeting governor Ganga Prasad on Sunday evening to stake claim to form the government with Conrad as chief minister.

The high voltage development took place a day after [Congress](#) got 21 seat, NPP 19, BJP 2 and UDP 6 seats with six independents who wants non [Congress](#) government in the [state](#).

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
