Folks in the rural areas have been performing door to door huchoris wishing every household a prosperous new Assamese calendar year which begins on Sunday.

In the urban areas Bihu functions showcasing colourful heritage are lined up from morning to midnight providing platforms for both young and old artists alike.

Prominent artists are pulling huge crowds in the urban areas where Bihu functions are holding for three or four days defying an inclement weather in some areas.
