DIBRUGARH: A local court in Dibrugarh disallowed police to arrest Akhil Gogoi in connection with a case pending against the KMSS [leader](#) in Dudhnoi.

A team of Goalpara police on Wednesday moved the additional chief judicial magistrate in Dibrugarh seeking permission to get Gogoi in their custody citing a case in Dudhnoi police station.

But the court rejected the plea a day before the Gauhati High Court's ruling on his bail [petition](#). The high court is clearing its ruling on Gogoi's bail [petition](#) on Thursday morning.

Dibrugarh police arrested Gogoi under NSA after he openly urged the people at a meeting to be prepared for an armed struggle.
