

Court reserves ruling on ACS-APS officers' bail plea



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GUWAHATI: A special court in Guwahati on Thursday reserved the ruling on a set of bail pleas moved by [over](#) 20 ACS, APS and allied service officers who have been arrested in the APSC [job](#) scam.

According to information, the special court heard the entire set of bail pleas from their appointed lawyers and reserved the ruling which is expected in a day or two.

Six ACS and APS officers have been remanded to judicial custody on Thursday after the police probing the scam produced them before the special court following the end of the 14 days police remand.

With this, only three officers have been escaping police arrest in this connection.

According to SS Ganesa, who is heading to special operation unit set up to [deal](#) with the case for the time being there is no other accused in this scam.

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
