

Cowhead brews tension in Barpeta



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Utter anger grips Bhawanipur area in Barpeta district on Monday a day after miscreants kept a cow head inside a local [temple](#) on Sunday suggesting an abortive attempt to create an orgy of communal clash. The incident came to light when a few local residents discovered a cow head inside the Madan Mohan Gosain Than Satra at Banglipara.

Senior police and civil officials arrived in the spot on receipt of the complaint. With sniffer dogs police tried to trace the miscreants. But nobody has so far been arrested or interrogated in this connection. Local residents vehemently condemned the miscreants and gave the police 24 hours deadline to nab the culprits involved in it.

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
