

Curfew reimposed in Haflong town

Fresh incidents of violence gripped Dima Hasao district after the district administration relaxed curfew in Haflong on Monday.

Supporters of the North Cachar Hills Indigenous Peoples Forum turned violent where policemen were attacked in Haflong town. Bandh supporters pelted stones at security forces at Mahadev Tilla and Harangajao. Policemen on duty were forced to fire rubber bullets to disperse the mob.

Some NCIPF activists came out into the streets in Haflong during the curfew relaxation period and set on fire a bike at Kalibari Road. This is apart from an incident where an autorickshaw was damaged at Gunjung area. Indefinite curfew was reimposed in the hills town following the incident.
