

Curfew relaxed till 8 PM in Golaghat



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Life is limping [back](#) to normalcy in [Golaghat](#) district. Curfew in the violence-hit district was relaxed for further two hours till 8 pm on [Saturday](#) following no fresh incident.

The prohibitory order imposed on April 20 was relaxed by the district administration for 14 hours from 6 am while it was 12 hours on Friday.

Night [curfew](#) from 8 pm to 6 am will, however, continue to be in [force](#). Talking to [Assam](#) Times, officials said that there is no report of any untoward incident during the last 48 hours.

Chief minister Tarun [Gogoi](#) also said the state government would provide adequate compensation and rehabilitate the people displaced by the recent violence along the [border](#) claiming nine lives.

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
