Pal said that the yatra will be cover [8](#) states i.e., Assam, West Bengal, Bihar, UP, Delhi, Haryana, Punjab and Jammu-Kashmir

He said that the cycle rally team will be meeting [President](#) and Vice [president](#) of [India](#) and also appeal to people to make a society free from intoxication, [drugs](#) etc.

Radha Batta secretary of the organizer said that after eruption of violence in Bodo area of Assam in 2012, Gandhian's from all [over](#) the country reached there for establishing peace and this works is going on for about four years now.
