

Dam equipment hits roadblock



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Amid massive security, a huge trailer is believed to have been carrying vital equipment for big dams in Arunachal Pradesh.

The trailer managed to cross Guwahati on Monday night and is set to reach Tezpur on Tuesday afternoon triggering protest in Nagaon.

KMSS activists, which has been dead opposed to the dams in Gerukamukh are trying to resist the move by holding road blockade in some places on the National Highway 37.
