

Deal with Maoists: Gogoi to Modi



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[Assam](#) Chief Minister Tarun [Gogoi](#) urged the [Centre](#) to set up a counter-insurgency coordination mechanism involving [police forces](#) to deal with the insurgency problem in the state.

During his [meeting](#) with prime minister Narendra [Modi](#) in New Delhi on Monday, [Gogoi](#) said that the Maoists have spread its base in some pockets of upper [Assam](#).
