

DHAC denies allegations against CEM

The Dima Hasao Autonomous Council vehemently denied the allegations against the Chief Executive Member Sri Debojeet Thaosen leveled by the ASDC Dima Hasao District committee, which was published in a section media recently.

Sri L. Khoubung, Principal Secretary (Transfer) and Sri Sunil Nunisa, Principal Secretary (Normal) categorically dismissed all the allegations raised by the ASDC terming it as baseless and fabricated.
