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MONGOLDOI: Yet another person succumbed to injuries in the police firing in Dhola on Wednesday triggering huge protest the sub urban area in Darranga district.

The seriously injured person who was among the hundreds of protesters succumbed to injuries at the Gauhati Medical College Hospital on Wednesday evening. He was shifted to Guwahati after policemen resorted to open firing to disperse the protestors in front of the police station hours after the custodial death of a local worker on Tuesday.
