

Digital India week celebrated



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The Digital India [Week](#) was [celebrated](#) in Chirang district with week-long programme from July 1-[7](#) along with rest of the country.

The programme was organized on the theme "Digital Governance for Accountability, Transparency and Speedy Services", in this connection, the Chirang Deputy Commissioner Rupak Kr. Mazumdar held a meeting of district heads of the departments on July [2](#) at his office and discussed on digital and various IT aspects.
