All the Government and semi-government offices remain closed except Deputy Commissioner's Office and SP's Office but with thin attendance. All the financial institutions, markets and even the educational institutions remain closed. All the private and government vehicles were off the roads. But the running of trains was normal. The Bandh was altogether total, spontaneous and peaceful. No untoward incidents reported so far.
