Nandalal Choudhury, adviser of the mansa strongly slammed the government of Assam and BTAD administration for not taking any sincerity steps towards implementation of the PWD [Act](#). There are various scope and facilities have been made in the PWD [Act](#) for disability, but [state](#) government never emphasize to give [job](#) opportunity [as](#) well [welfare](#) for the disability persons, he said.
