

Dissidents met Ahmed Patel



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At least 12 [Congress](#) legislators have been camping in [New Delhi](#) to revive the dissidence against Tarun Gogoi as chief minister.

They met AICC [leader](#) Ahmed Patel on Tuesday and demanded implementation of the Mallikarjun Kharge report at an earlier date.
