

Doctor kidnapped at gunpoint from Guwahati

The heavy security presence in Guwahati seems to have failed to halt the repeated incidents of murder and kidnapping in Guwahati.

Suspected ULFA militants have kidnapped a doctor from the city at gun point on Tuesday. The incident took place at 9 in the evening when three unidentified armed miscreants took away doctor MC Agarwalla from his chamber at Fancybazar based Dhanuka Complex.

Top ranked police and civil officials have rushed to the spot and search operation is going on. Police officials tracing the development are clueless so far.
