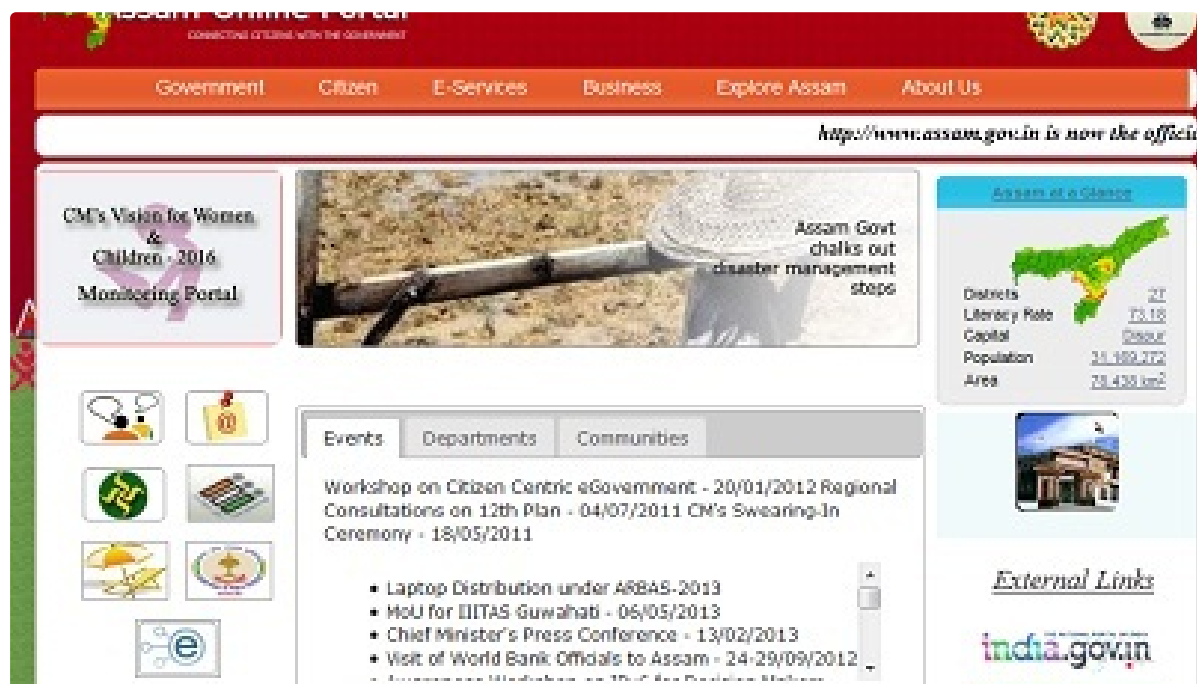


Documents at a mouse click



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Altogether 42 G2C citizen-centric services are electronically available. That too at a mouse click. Now only you need to visit the <http://www.assam.gov.in>. These services can be applied for at the public facilitation centres (PFCs) available at DC-[SDO](#)-CO offices across the [state](#).

Those who do not have any access to these offices are free to move the common service centres at the door steps. Named [as](#) SUGAM, [chief](#) minister [Tarun Gogoi](#) [launched](#) the service at a brief function in Guwahati on Tuesday
