

Don't waste public money: Patowary to Gogoi



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The Opposition Asom Gana Parishad demands Assam Chief Minister Tarun Gogoi's resignation charging him with making frequent foreign tours at the cost of the state exchequer.

Addressing a press conference in Guwahati on Sunday, party president Chandra Mohan Patowary said Gogoi may justify saying that he visited the nations to get a first hand information about the latest technology. Patowary said if he really thinks so he should refrain from wasting public money.
