

Driver missing with cash



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The Guwahati policemen are launching an operation in search of a Brinks Arya [driver](#) who went missing with a huge amount of money from the [city](#) he was carrying to put in ATM booths along with three others.

Identified [as](#) Rubul Barman, he went missing from Ganesguri area when a HDFC bank official, security guard and an ATM worker were depositing cash at an ATM booth.

The [driver](#) took Rs 1.80 crore in cash from the [vehicle](#) and vanished from the scene. When the three others returned to the [vehicle](#) the [driver](#) was not [found](#) inside the [vehicle](#) forcing them to move police. The police have detained the HDFC bank official and security guard for questionings.

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
