

Drug baron hurt in Guwahati shoot out



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GUWAHATI: Despite round-the-clock vigil, armed miscreants keep moving in Guwahati to monger more trouble.

Yet another [shoot](#) out incident rocked the city on Wednesday where Pakhi Miya sustained injury. The incident took place when the drug lord was traveling from Behorbari to Bhetapara by his car.

Suddenly, an armed miscreant who was following him on a gipsy started indiscriminate firing at the Scorpio in which Pakhi Miya was travelling at around 8 in the evening.

Hati Gaon police have accepted the complaint and registered a case. The drug lord came out of the jail a couple of months back on bail. Police investigation is going on.

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
