The impasse inside the Dibrugarh University remains even after the authorities agreed to roll back the recent fee hike. Talking to Assamtimes, the leaders of the varsity's post graduate students union said they are not ready to lift the agitation until and unless the vice chancellor resigns, ban on DUPGSU is lifted and the cases against DUPGSU leaders are withdrawn. The students have boycotted their classes, hoisted black flags inside the varsity campus and are on hunger strike. The decision to scale down fee was taken on Saturday.
