

E-service ready for police



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Come January 1, [2016](#). The Assam police force is all set to [start](#) an e service to take the crime and [criminal](#) tracking network close to the people.

Set up under the CCTNS project, the service will help the citizens get police help through online apart from the existing services.

Beside, it will help the people verify the characters of the domestic helps and assistance, get character certificates, obtain permission for dharna, procession.

The authority expects help and suggestion from the citizens to improve the police services through citizensupport@assampolice.assam.gov.in.

The portal has a video to be visited by the citizen. [SMS](#) options are available by logging in OTP Log in the portal along with the email address of all SPs in the districts. But the service, initially, would be absent from 97 police station where BSNL facilities are not available.

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
