

East Siang achieves 90.78% biometric enrollment



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The District Level Training for updating of NPR database and seeding Aadhar number in NPR database was held here at DC's [Conference](#) Hall on Wednesday. ADCs of [Pasighat](#), Ruksin, Nari and Mebo and administrative officers were present. Joint Director of Census Operations, Bharti Chanda from Shillong imparted the daylong [training](#) program.

Chairing the meeting cum [training](#) programme, the Deputy Commissioner In-charge Deepak Shinde informed that East [Siang](#) District has achieved 90.78% biometric enrollment under active supervision of DSO (Stat) D Naksang.
