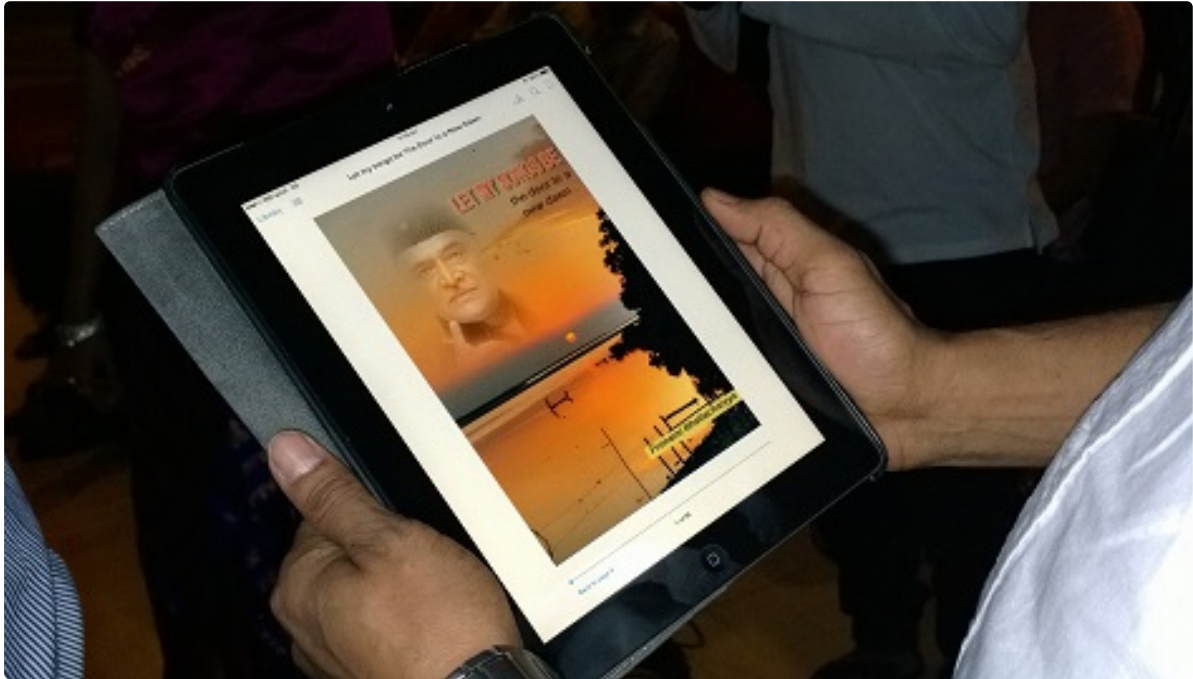


eBook keeps music maestro alive
