

Eerie silence in Bordumsa after ULFA-I strike



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TINSUKIA: Security forces are fanning in the nook and corner of Bordumsa a day after suspected [ULFA](#)-I shot dead a villager and his son triggering anger across the [state](#).

Police, army and para military forces are conducting combing operation in some vulnerable areas in search of the rebels who killed Anteswar Mahanta and his son in the evening.

Security forces have cordoned off a huge area to nab the six [gunmen](#) who are believed to have been hiding somewhere along the Assam-[Arunachal](#) Pradesh border.

Shock and anger grip thr entire area as many parties, organizations and individuals have condemned the inhuman killing on Mahanta and his son who married two months back.
