

Emfa ridicules Papon's diktat for media



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Electronic Media Forum Assam (Emfa) expresses shock & dismay at the audacity of a popular [Assamese](#) personality to diktat terms for the electronic media. The forum also asks singer Angarag Papon Mahanta to keep away from such unwanted activities in future.
