

Eviction will never stop: Pramila



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GUWAHATI: Even an escalating protest across the [state](#) can't halt the massive eviction drive if [Pramila](#) Rami Brahma is to be believed.

Talking to reporters in Guwahati on Monday the forest minister said at any cost the illegal settlers must be evicted from Amchang, Karbi Anglong, Lakhimpur where forest department and district administrations are jointly running the drive from Monday.
