

Fellowship and contest for photographers



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Centre for Science and [Environment](#) (CSE) and Down To Earth magazine invites photographers and photo-journalists to apply for a fellowship and a contest on the subject of 'climate change and vulnerable communities'. The fellowship is aimed at recording stories of people and places buffeted by changing climate and its accompanying extremes of weather; and of communities and individuals who are facing these phenomena with resilience and patience, adapting with intelligence and devising innovative responses.
