According to the sources, Bulen Gogoi, Komola Saikia with 6 other labours who worked in the coal fields in Nagaland came to face with the NSCN(IM) group on their way to home for Magh Bihu. Though the labours fled safely it is unknown about the causalities of the NSCN groups.

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
