Led by Chatra Mukti Sangram Samity's [Tinsukia](#) district committee, the local residents joined the mock session alleging that Pradyut Bordoloi from [Congress](#) has been doing nothing on this front. Same allegations they raised against the incumbent legislator Bhaskar Sarma who has done precious little so far.

CMSS [leader](#) Lakhya Jyoti Gogoi said," we have already moved the MLA many times. But of no avail. We have no option but to resort to this course of action to draw the attention of the authority."
