

Flood: SC notice to Delhi, Dispur

The government failure to check flood and erosion have reached the Supreme Court when the apex court on Monday asked Delhi and Dispur to respond to a plea that the failure of effective flood management in the state.

Admitting a PIL filed by BJP leader Pradyut Bora, a division bench headed by Chief Justice Altamas Kabir issued notice to the Arunachal Pradesh government as the petitioner claimed that being an upper riparian state, the neighbouring state has not done enough to combat flood.
