

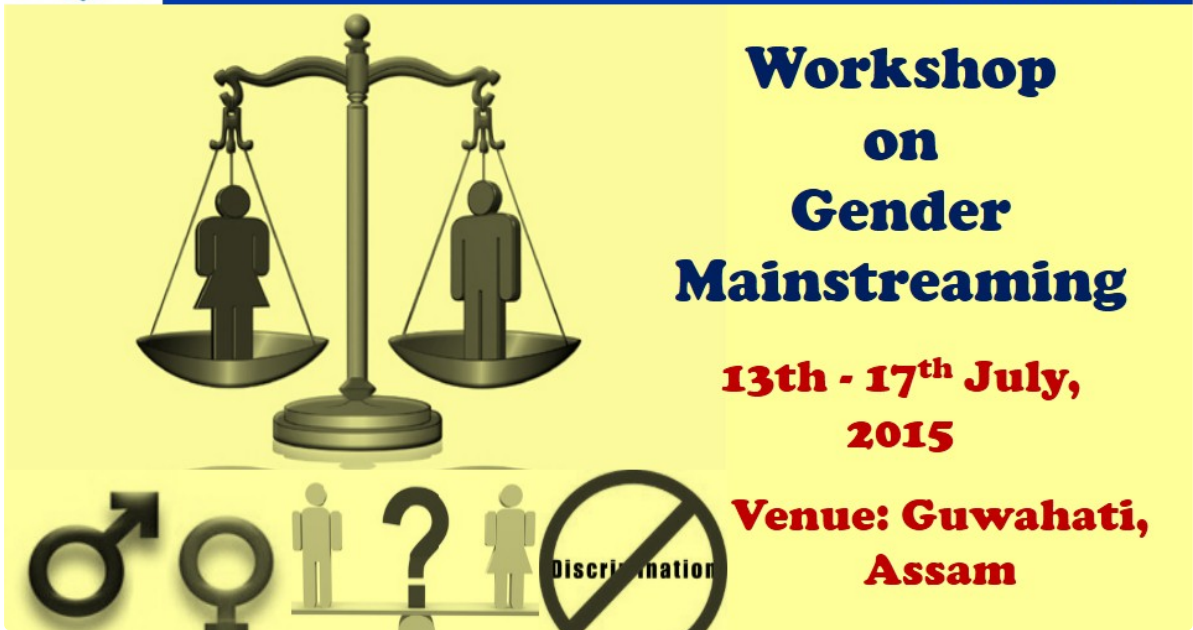

A five day residential [workshop](#) on Gender Mainstreaming is going to be organized by Rajiv [Gandhi National](#) Institute of Youth Development and North East Youth Foundation at Guwahati, Assam from 13th July, 2015 to 17th July, 2015. The [workshop](#) will take 50 participants from different parts of North East India. Despite constitutional guarantees of democracy and equality, women in India remain discriminated [against](#) and highly vulnerable to gender-based violence. A strong patriarchal tradition limits the opportunities of women to access education, health, employment opportunities. India's women-to-men demographic ratio (940:1000) emphasizes the sex preference for men. Moreover, direct gender-based violence is increasing at an alarming rate. The focus of this [workshop](#) will be to inculcate the values and teachings for Gender Equality. The [workshop](#) is designed in a logical and systematic way that include relevant academic sessions through participatory methodologies.
