Forest officials attacked

Despite a set of strictures timber smugglers ([/taxonomy/term/2244](#)) are still active in the BTAD forest areas. Four forest officials sustained injury when timber smugglers ([/taxonomy/term/2244](#)) attacked them at Jharbari in Kokrajhar district on Thursday. The incident of attack took place in the wee hours where a huge group of teak smugglers ([/taxonomy/term/2244](#)) targeted Jharbari Ranger Manik Brahma along with three of his assistants. Others include Rajendra Muchahary, Prahlad Borgoyary and Amio Muchahary. Armed with sharp weapons and sticks, the smugglers ([/taxonomy/term/2244](#)) numbering around 35-40 started beating up the forest officials as they spotted them travelling on Zypsi and a Tata mobile van which were also damaged. Eight other officials, however, managed to escape the attack.
