

Former Bihar MP in legal trouble



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A former MP from Bihar lands in legal trouble as he approached the Gauhati High Court against Assam health minister Himanta Biswa Sarma. A division bench of Gauhati High Court has rejected writ petition filed by Bihar's former MP Sukhdeo Paswan who said that his public interest litigation for reopening TADA cases against the minister Sarma should be reopened. In a sudden move, Paswan filed the writ petition on Wednesday seeking withdrawal of the PIL. The court, however, denied it and instead asked him to file an affidavit by September 3 justifying his latest move.

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
